Subject:- Advance increments to persons who qualify in the Departmental Examination prescribed for the next higher grade - Extension of benefit to Stenographer (Senior Grade) on passing the Departmental Examination for Income-tax Officers -

I am directed to invite your attention to this Department's letter No.A-26017/62/76-Ad.IX, dated the 19th February, 1977, in which the benefit of two advance increments, envisaged in the Department of Revenue letter No.2(29)-Adm.VII/53, dated 24.7.55 and F.No.6/83/57-Ad.IX, dated 8.12.60 was extended to Stenographers (S.G.) on passing the Income-tax Officers' examination. This benefit is admissible from the date of issue of the letter i.e. 19.2.1977. In regard to Stenographers (S.G.) who passed the Income-tax Officer's examination before 19.2.1977, it has been decided that the pay in such a case may be stepped up to the level of pay of his junior who qualified that examination after 19.2.1977 and got the benefit of the advance increments.

2. I am, accordingly to convey the sanction of the President to the stepping up of pay of Senior Stenographers (S.G.), who passed the Income-tax Officers' Examination before 19.2.1977 and did not get the benefit of two advance increments, to the level of pay of his junior who qualified the Said examination after 19.2.77 and got the benefit of two advance increments.

3. This issues with the concurrence of Department of Expenditure vide their U.O.No.1687-B.III(A)/77, dated 7.4.1977.
