Sir,

I am directed to invite attention to Board's letter of even number dated 31.3.98, 16.9.98 and 11.11.99 outlining the guidelines to be followed for reimbursement of petrol expenses to Inspectors of Income Tax for performing Official Journey.

- 2. The guidelines outlined in the aforementioned letters for reimbursement of petrol expenses have been reviewed in consultation with the Principal Chief Controller of Accounts, CBDT and it has been decided that the claim of reimbursement can be admitted by certifying the incurring of actual expenditure by the claimant Inspector with counter signature of the controlling officer. The details of journey will also be indicated for record purposes. This is subject to the following:
 - (i) An ITI can avail any one of the entitlements i.e. TA/DA, Conveyance Allowance or reimbursement of Petrol, whichever is beneficial to him and subject to the relevant rules, if any, in a given month.
 - (ii) The Inspectors will be required to give a certificate every month in the following format duly countersigned by an officer specified for this purpose by the concerned Commissioners;
