G.S.R. _____In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Finance, Department of Revenue, Income Tax Department (Inspector) Recruitment Rules, 1969 as amended from time to time except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Inspector of Income Tax in the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT), Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, namely:-

- Short title and commencement-(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Finance,
 Department of Revenue, Central Board of Direct Taxes,
 Inspector of Income Tax, Group 'B' Posts Recruitment Rules,
 2021.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, Classification and Pay Level in the Pay Matrix The number of the said posts, their classification and the Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- **3.Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications, etc.**—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

Provided that the recruitment by promotion against posts in the Region of a Cadre Controlling Authority shall be made only from amongst persons belonging to the cadres of that Region, as indicated against column 11 of the Schedule.

4. Disqualifications - No person,

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultations with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

- **6. Saving**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and any other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
- 7. **Promotion---**For promotion, common seniority list of both cadres **Office Superintendent (O.S.)** and **Stenographer Grade I** will be prepared as per entry into the **Pay Level 6** in the Pay Matrix Rs. 35,400 1,12,400 in Pay Band-2 Rs. 9,300-34,800 with **Grade Pay 4200**. In cases where the date of entry into the cadre of Office Superintendent and Stenographer Grade-I, as the case may be is the same, the inter se seniority shall be decided as below:
 - (i) By the total length of service in the Income Tax Department in all cadres together with the person having longer service placed above the person with lesser service.
 - (ii) Then by Date of Birth with the older placed above the younger.

- 1. Promotion to the grade of Inspector of Income Tax will be made region/charge-wise.
- For the purpose of reckoning five years' regular service in the grade of Office Superintendent in the Level 6 in the Pay Matrix (Rs. 35,400 - 1,12,400) in Pay Band-2 Rs. 9,300-34,800 with Grade Pay 4200, regular service rendered by the official in the erstwhile grades of Office Superintendent and Senior Tax Assistant prior to the merger of the grades of Office Superintendent and Senior Tax Assistant combined Grade of 'Office into the Superintendent' shall be counted as regular service in the grade of 'Office Superintendent'. For the purpose of reckoning five years' regular service in the grade of Stenographer Grade - I in the Level 6 in the Pay Matrix (Rs. 35,400 -1,12,400) in Pay Band-2 Rs. 9,300-34,800 with Grade Pay 4200, regular service rendered by the official in the erstwhile grades of Stenographer Grade - I in scale of pay of Rs. 9000 (including erstwhile 5500 - Rs. Stenographer Grade-II in scale of pay of Rs. 5000 - Rs. 8000) shall be counted as regular service in the grade of Stenographer Grade - I.
- 3. Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered, provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.
- 4. The eligibility service for promotion to the grade of Inspector of Income Tax shall continue to be three years for existing employees holding the feeder cadre of **Office Superintendent** in Level 6 in Pay Matrix in the Pay Matrix (Rs. 35,400 1,12,400) in Pay Band 2 Rs.9300-34800 plus Grade Pay 4200 &

Stenographer Grade - I in Level 6 in the Pay Matrix (Rs. 35,400 – 1,12,400) in Pay Band 2 Rs.9300-34800 plus Grade Pay 4200 on regular basis on the date of notification of the revised rules.
