### Sub: <u>Sanction for hiring of Additional Operational Vehicles and final</u> Deployment of Operational Vehicles – regarding.

I am directed to convey the administrative approval and financial sanction of the President of India for hiring of 701 additional Operational Vehicles (Mid size vehicles) at the existing ceiling rate of Rs.40,000/- per month per vehicle for the 701 new Assessment Ranges and additional offices created under various Directorates, in the Income Tax Department consequent to the cadre restructuring.

2. In supersession of all allocations of Operational Vehicles made earlier, the Region wise final allocation of Operational Vehicles (both owned and hired) is given below:

3. Subsequent to the allocation as given in Para-2 above, the final allocation of Operation Vehicles (both department owned and hired by the department), Region wise and Unit wise is given in Annexura-A. The Pr.CCsIT are requested to allocate the Operational Vehicles as per this distribution.

4. The Operational Vehicles have been allocated separately for the Pr. CCsIT Regions, DGsIT (Inv.), NADT & RTIs, Directorates of the CBDT and DGIT(I&CI). In Pr. CCIT, Delhi and Mumbai Regions, the Operational Vehicles required by Central Charges i.e. CIT(Central) and CIT(A), Central have been allocated to Pr. CCIT, Delhi and Mumbai Region respectively. In all other regions such vehicles have been allocated to the respective DGsIT(Inv.).

5. Other than the government owned vehicles which are being used as Operational Vehicles, remaining Operational Vehicles shall be hired at the actual rates, within the above noted ceiling rates, after following all formalities for selection of vendors as per the provisions of GFRs. Further, the actual of hiring of Operational Vehicles for the new Ranges/Offices shall be subject to the notification of the concerned office and the actual joining of the officers in the new post. It shall be ensured that the cars hired are not old and are fit and in proper running condition.

6. Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for hiring and use of operational vehicles have been prescribed, which are being sent separately. The concerned controlling authorities must ensure that these instructions are followed.

7. An Annual Information Report regarding of staff cars and operational vehicles has also been prescribed which is being sent separately. The concerned controlling authorities must ensure that the Annual Information Report in the prescribed proforma is sent by 30<sup>th</sup> April for the year ending on 31<sup>st</sup> March.

8. The expenditure on account of hiring of these Operational Vehicles shall be debitable to the Head of Accounts ""Office Expenses" under the Demand for Grant No.43 – Direct Taxes, Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance and will be met out from the budgetary grant under the head ""Office Expenses" allocated to the respective Budgetary Authorities.

9. Attention is also invited to OM Dy. No.418/FA(F)/2004 dated 04.04.2006 issued by the Department of Revenue delegating the full financial powers to HODs in respect of hiring of vehicles in replacement of regularly (Mature) condemned vehicles, subject to GFRs 2005 and instructions Issued from time to time. In case of replacement hiring in lieu of premature condemnation of vehicles, a reference is required to be made to the Board.

10. This is issued with the concurrence of the IFU-III vide their F.No.DIT(Inf,)Unit-II/Inc-Vehicles/2012-13 dated 16.01.2015, Sanction Drder No.AA/11/2014-15-Ad.VIII(DT). The final allocation of Operational Vehicles has been approved by the Member (P&V).
