It has been also decided to create 98 (ninety eight) posts of Staff Car Drivers in the Pay Scale of Rs.950-1500 (Staff Car Driver, Ordinary Grade) in lieu of equal number of Group 'D' posts in your charge which will stand abolished from the date(s) these posts of Drivers are filled up. You are requested to accordingly reduce the sanctioned strength of Group 'D' cadre(s) in your charge. These posts of Drivers may be filled up in accordance with the Income-tax Department (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1990, as amended.
4. The expenditure involved in strengthening of above mentioned infrastructural facilities will be debited to the Head of Account 'Office Expenses'.
5. This sanction issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division VIDE their reference No. 2968/FAF-97 dated 15.7.97. Necessary augmentation in budgetary allocation would be made in R.E. 1997-98.
